

**Lawton Area Fun Flyer's Society**  
Minutes from Oct. 5, 2011 Meeting

President Ken Isaac called the meeting to order with the introduction of the above guests, and the welcome of member, Scott Hottois, who was here visiting from Michigan. Minutes from the September meeting were approved on a motion by Clem Wehner and a second by Bob McFadden. Brent Brennan presented the treasurer's report showing a balance in the club treasury of \$2715.38 with all bills paid. Brent noted that the field lease payment of \$1200 will need to be made shortly, and that annual dues would be collected at the November meeting. The treasurer's report was accepted on a motion by Gary Fletcher and a second by Steve Jakubiszyn.

**Old Business:**

1. *Extension of field lease*—President Isaac pointed out that we would be in our last year of the existing five-year lease of the field beginning in 2012, and that a luncheon meeting would be held in the near future with the owners to express the club's desire to renew the lease for another five years. Some discussion occurred concerning the future replacement of the runway, and that being contingent upon the renewal of the lease.
2. *Election of officers and payment of annual dues*—President Isaac reminded members that the November is the month for election of club officers and the payment of 2012 annual dues. Current officers are: Ken Isaac, president; Ron Hipp, vice-president; Brent Brennan, treasurer; Larry Kruse, *ad hoc* secretary; Paul Phillips, safety officer. Annual dues remain at \$100 for full membership, payable in November.
3. *Fun-Fly reschedule*—Due to several conflicts, the Fall Fun-Fly set for October 15, was put on hold and will be rescheduled in the Spring. President Isaac encouraged everyone to use the Oct. 15 date as an unofficial gathering for fellowship and flying.
4. *Bulk purchase of fuel*—Ron Hipp had provided information about bulk fuel purchases by way of an e-mail attachment prior to the meeting. After several discussion regarding pricing and the availability of specific fuel blends from several companies, the consensus was to make a decision about whether or not to purchase fuel in bulk amounts at the November meeting. In the meantime, Ron

will check on several of the questions members raised and bring that information to the November meeting, also.

5. *Building contest information*—Larry Kruse gave a brief report on the status of the annual building contest, reconfigured as a “Member’s Choice” contest, beginning with the September meeting date and concluding in March. Larry said that at this time there are twelve members signed up to participate. He noted that entry in the contest can occur at any time up until and including the date set to select the “Member’s Choice” winners.

**New Business:**

1. *Fall field clean-up*—President Isaac noted the need for a work session to prepare the field for the winter months. It was determined that since the Fall Fun-fly had been put on hold that Oct. 15 would be a good time to do that. Larry Kruse said he will get over to the field before that date and mow around the run-way and the pit area. Some prop strikes and loose patches in the runway will need to be repaired and the trash needs to be hauled off as part of the clean-up day.
