Minutes from April 6, 2010 Meeting

Prior to the meeting coming to order, Clem Wehner took individual photos of members who were present at that time. These photos are now posted on the club website. President Ken Isaac called the meeting to order at 6:10 p.m. Minutes from the previous meeting were approved by way of a motion from Paul Phillips and a second from Brent Brennan. The treasurer's report showed a balance of \$2,822.95 in the club account with some expenditures still outstanding and income from the last indoor fun fly and recent dues payments not yet reflected.

Old Business:

1. *"Members Area" on website*—Clem Wehner invited all of those who had not yet had their photos taken for inclusion on the web site to make themselves available after the meeting. At this time there are 20 members who have their pictures posted in the members' gallery.
2. *Elgin Boy Scout Troop*—President Isaac reported that he, Chip Gibson, Owen Gibson, Clem Wehner, and Larry Kruse, conducted a program for the Elgin Boy Scout Troop on March 22nd. Clem Wehner has a very nice report and photos of that activity in the latest issue of the club on-line electronic newsletter. President Isaac said that introductory activity would be followed up by an outdoor flying session.

New Business:

1. *Boy Scout flying day*—President Isaac announced that the outdoor flying day for the Elgin Boy Scouts was set for Saturday, April 17. There was some discussion that a back-up day ought to be set to account for bad weather. The consensus was that April 24 would be the back-up day. Agreement was also arrived at that some type of refreshments should be offered to the Scouts on a motion by Paul Phillips and a second by Chip Gibson.
2. *Field clean-up day*—President Isaac asked for in-put for scheduling a field clean-up day and agreement was reached that April 18 be set for that activity. Larry Kruse mentioned that some of the ground staples on the south and west edge of

- the runway were being raised by the wind and would need some attention. He also reported that Steve Jakubiszyn had built and donated a very sturdy and well-finished picnic table that was now under the shelter. Steve said he would be willing to construct another table if club members wanted it. Based on his cost, Larry Kruse moved and Chip Gibson seconded that Steve be allocated \$110 for construction and materials for the two tables. The motion passed unanimously and with appreciative applause for Steve's good work.
3. *Indoor schedule for fall*—President Isaac reminded members that the last indoor session of the season was set for Saturday, March 8. Larry Kruse asked members when they would like to resume flying in the fall. A request was made that the flying session be scheduled somewhat later in the month to allow for some member's work schedules. Accordingly, Saturday, Sept. 18 was set as the first session in the fall. Larry said he would meet with Cameron officials and move the flying schedule from the first Saturday of each month until later in the month if possible, depending on University usage.
 4. *Reserve account*—Some discussion took place concerning the possibility of the club opening a reserve account to set aside money for the eventual replacement of the runway material, as well as some larger projects that might want to be done. No action took place, but there was a consensus to continue discussion of the idea.

Show and tell:

Larry Kruse brought a newly completed "Dynaflite Bird of Time ARF" standard class glider spanning 118". He indicated that the kit was good and he was particularly pleased with the molded fiberglass fuselage, but that the covering was sub-standard and most probably had been put on at an excessively high temperature. The plane was awaiting its first flight pending the arrival of a new heavy-duty high-start.
